DIVISION 2. HEALING ARTS [500 - 4999.129] (Division 2 enacted by Stats. 1937, Ch. 399.) CHAPTER 1. General Provisions [500 - 865.2] (Chapter 1 enacted by Stats. 1937, Ch. 399.)

ARTICLE 14. Gerontology and Geriatric Training for the Healing Arts [860- 860.] (Article 14 added by Stats. 2002, Ch. 541, Sec. 3.)

- **860.** (a) The Legislature finds and declares both of the following:
 - (1) California's system of care suffers from a severe shortage of professionals and paraprofessionals in the healing arts to administer programs and provide services for older adults.
 - (2) As a result of rapidly changing age demographics in California, it is essential that we prepare a sufficient number of competent and qualified professionals and paraprofessionals in the healing arts to administer programs for, and provide services to, California's older adults and adults with disabilities.
- (b) It is the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to require various professionals and paraprofessionals in the healing arts to complete certain educational requirements in aging and long-term care as a condition or licensure or renewal of licensure, or both.
