ARTICLE 5.4. Subhauling Agreements [19266 - 19266.2] (Article 5.4 added by Stats. 2017, Ch. 421, Sec. 8.)

19266. A household mover shall not transport household goods under a subhauling agreement unless each of the following occurs:

- (a) The subhauler is permitted by the bureau to transport household goods and complies with the requirements of this chapter.
- (b) The household mover and subhauler are jointly and severally liable for any loss or damage caused by the subhauler.

19266.1. The bureau shall adopt any rules and regulations it determines to be necessary to enforce the requirements of this article. (Added by Stats. 2017, Ch. 421, Sec. 8. (SB 19) Effective January 1, 2018.)

19266.2. This article does not apply to a subhauling agreement when the subhauler is not otherwise subject to this chapter for activity related to the subhauling agreement.
