DIVISION 2. CLASSES OF INSURANCE [1880 - 12880.8] (Division 2 enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.) PART 1. FIRE AND MARINE INSURANCE [1880 - 10108.1] (Part 1 enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.) CHAPTER 8. Underwriters Fire Patrols [10020 - 10080] (Chapter 8 enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.)

ARTICLE 1. Scope of Chapter and Definitions [10020 - 10022] (Article 1 enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.)

10020. As used in this chapter, an underwriters' corps means a corps of men with proper officers and equipment, maintained to discover and prevent fires and save life and property from fire.

(Enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.)

10021. This chapter shall not impair or interfere with the powers or duties of the regular fire department of any municipality. (Enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.)

10022. Any act of an underwriters' corps shall not justify any owner of any property in abandoning such property. (Enacted by Stats. 1935, Ch. 145.)
