ARTICLE 8. Payment of Premiums [1650 - 1653] (Article 8 enacted by Stats. 1943, Ch. 134.)

1650. This article does not apply to notaries public.

(Enacted by Stats. 1943, Ch. 134.)

- 1651. The premium or charge for bonds given by surety companies for the officers, herein named, and for their deputies, clerks, assistants or subordinate officers shall be paid as follows:
- (a) State officers, by the State.
- (b) County officers, by the county.
- (c) Officers of a judicial district, by the county in which the district is situated.
- (d) School districts or other special district officers, by the school district or other special district, respectively.
- (e) City officers, by the city.

1652. No premium or charge paid by the state, a county, city, or district shall exceed one-half of 1 percent per annum on the amount of the bond, but a minimum premium or charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25) per annum may be imposed.

1653. The payment of premiums for all bonds of deputies, clerks, assistants or subordinate officers of county officers shall not be a county charge unless the amount fixed for such bond has been approved by the board of supervisors.
