PART 4. HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) [120775 - 121349.3] (Part 4 added by Stats. 1995, Ch. 415, Sec. 7.

CHAPTER 1. Definitions [120775- 120775.] (Chapter 1 added by Stats. 1995, Ch. 415, Sec. 7.)

120775. As used in this code:

- (a) "AIDS" means acquired immune deficiency syndrome.
- (b) "Human immunodeficiency virus" or "HIV" means the etiologic virus of AIDS.
- (c) "HIV test" means any clinical test, laboratory or otherwise, used to identify HIV, a component of HIV, or antibodies or antigens to HIV.
