**CHAPTER 30**

An act to add Section 6727 to the Government Code, relating to state observances.

[ Approved by Governor June 28, 2017. Filed with Secretary of State June 28, 2017. ]

**LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST**

AB 88, Nazarian. Nowrūz Day.

Existing law requires the Governor to proclaim various days in honor of a person, status, or an event.

This bill would require the Governor annually to proclaim the day of the astronomical Northward equinox, which usually occurs on March 20 or the following day, as Nowrūz Day.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 6727 is added to the Government Code, to read:

**6727.** The Governor shall annually proclaim the day of the astronomical Northward equinox, which usually occurs on March 20 or the following day, as Nowrūz Day.
