## Senate Bill No. 141

## CHAPTER 242

An act to add Section 3053.9 to the Penal Code, relating to parole.

[Approved by Governor September 05, 2019. Filed with Secretary of State September 05, 2019. ]

## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 141, Bates. Parole: sexually violent offenses: validated risk assessment.

Existing law grants the Board of Parole Hearings the power to grant parole to prisoners.

This bill would, if an inmate has a prior conviction for a sexually violent offense, as defined, require the board to consider the results of a comprehensive risk assessment for sex offenders in considering parole.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Section 3053.9 is added to the Penal Code, to read:

3053.9. If an inmate has a prior conviction for a sexually violent offense, as defined in subdivision (b) of Section 6600 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, the board shall consider the results of a comprehensive risk assessment for sex offenders in considering parole.
