CHAPTER 83

An act to amend Section 483 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to transportation.

[Approved by Governor September 11, 2020. Filed with Secretary of State September 11, 2020.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1459, Caballero. State highways: relinquishment: State Route 183.

Existing law describes the authorized routes in the state highway system and establishes a process for adoption of a highway on an authorized route by the California Transportation Commission. Existing law requires the commission to relinquish to local agencies state highway segments that have been deleted from the state highway system by legislative enactment or have been superseded by relocation, and in certain other cases.

This bill would authorize the commission to relinquish to the City of Salinas a segment of State Highway Route 183, under specific conditions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 483 of the Streets and Highways Code is amended to read:

483. (a) Route 183 is from Route 101 in the City of Salinas to Route 1 near Castroville.

(b) Upon a determination by the commission that it is in the best interests of the state to do so, the commission may, upon terms and conditions approved by it, relinquish to the City of Salinas the portion of Route 183 within its jurisdiction, if the department and the city enter into an agreement providing for that relinquishment.

(c) The following conditions apply upon relinquishment:

(1) The relinquishment shall become effective on the date following the county recorder's recordation of the relinquishment resolution containing the commission's approval of the terms and conditions of the relinquishment.

(2) On and after the effective date of the relinquishment, the relinquished portion of Route 183 shall cease to be a state highway.

(3) The entirety of Route 183 relinquished under this section shall be ineligible for future adoption under Section 81.
