CHAPTER 321

An act to amend Section 179.9 of the Government Code, relating to emergency services.

[Approved by Governor September 15, 2022. Filed with Secretary of State September 15, 2022.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1565, Committee on Emergency Management. Emergency Management Assistance Compact.

Existing law ratifies, approves, and sets forth the provisions of the Emergency Management Assistance Compact, an interstate agreement that provides for mutual assistance between states responding to emergencies and disasters. The compact becomes inoperative on March 1, 2023, and, as of January 1, 2024, is repealed.

This bill instead would make the compact inoperative on March 1, 2028, and repeal it on January 1, 2029.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 179.9 of the Government Code is amended to read:

179.9. This article shall become inoperative on March 1, 2028, and, as of January 1, 2029, is repealed.
