An act to amend Section 12288 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

[Approved by Governor August 22, 2022. Filed with Secretary of State August 22, 2022.]

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2037, Flora. Polling places: alcoholic beverages.

Existing law prohibits an establishment where the primary purpose is the sale and dispensation of alcoholic beverages from being used as a polling place.

This bill would delete that prohibition.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 12288 of the Elections Code is amended to read:

12288. A polling place shall not be accessible by a door, window, or other opening to any place where any alcoholic beverage is sold or dispensed while the polls are open.
