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## AB-15 Budget Act of 2024. (2025-2026)

An act to amend the Budget Act of 2024 (Chs. 22, 35, and 994, Stats. 2024), by amending Section 99.50 of, and by adding Section 5.27 to, that act, relating to the state budget, and making an appropriation therefor, to take effect immediately, budget bill.

#### LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

This bill would amend the Budget Act of 2024 by making changes to existing appropriations, as provided.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as a Budget Bill.

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Section 5.27 is added to the Budget Act of 2024, to read:

SEC. 5.27. Notwithstanding any other law, funds allocated or augmented for the purpose of grants, contracts, or state operations as items of appropriation in Section 2.00 shall not be used to obstruct or interfere with federal enforcement actions or legal proceedings against individuals convicted of a felony who are present in the United States in violation of federal immigration laws. This restriction includes, but is not limited to, expenditures on litigation, administrative actions, or any other measures intended to shield such individuals from federal apprehension or deportation.

SEC. 2. Section 99.50 of the Budget Act of 2024 is amended to read:

**SEC. 3.** This act is a Budget Bill within the meaning of subdivision (e) of Section 12 of Article IV of the California Constitution and shall take effect immediately.
