SUBJECT: **NEW EMERGENCY INTERVENTION REGULATIONS FOR ADULT DAY PROGRAMS**

Provider Information Notice (PIN) Summary

PIN 22-22-ASC announces new regulations related to the use of Emergency Intervention in Adult Day Programs, effective July 1, 2022.

Effective July 1st, 2022, the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 22, Division 6, Chapter 3 has been amended to include [Subchapter 1 Emergency Intervention \(EI\) in Adult Day Programs](#) (ADPs). These regulations align with the existing [Adult Residential Facility Emergency Intervention](#) regulations given both categories support the same population. The Emergency Intervention regulations are necessary to ensure providers are aware of additional requirements if an ADP uses or foresees the need for the use of emergency interventions in their facility.

These regulations clarify what is an appropriate use of a restraint and/or seclusion (emergency interventions) in ADPs. They also specify prohibited techniques and requirements for an initial assessment of each person for whom emergency interventions may potentially be employed.
