## **All Facilities Letter (AFL) Summary**

This AFL notifies all Medicare and/or Medicaid certified nursing facilities about the revised RAI 3.0 user's manual including the new Minimum Data Set (MDS) 3.0 item sets that took effect on October 1, 2018.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) publishes the RAI 3.0 User's Manual v1.16 as a public document which is available for duplication. The goal is to distribute information broadly to facilitate accurate and effective resident assessment practices in long-term care facilities.

The 3.0 manual v1.16 is available for print/download at the CMS website.

The 2018 MDS items sets (v1.16.1) are available on the CMS MDS 3.0 Technical Information webpage.
