## 449.61338 Employment and duties of chief nurse; size of on-duty nursing staff; limitation on scope of practice by person who is not registered nurse; oversight of nursing staff

## 1.

Each independent center for emergency medical care shall employ a chief nurse who is a registered nurse and is responsible for the supervision and evaluation of the nursing staff and its activities. The chief nurse shall: (a) Establish job descriptions for the nursing staff of the center; (b) Provide for the orientation and training of the nursing staff; (c) Evaluate the performance of the nursing staff; and (d) Assign nurses.

## 2.

A sufficient number of members of the nursing staff must be on duty at all times

during the operation of the center to ensure: (a) That proper care is provided to each patient; and (b) The immediate availability of a registered nurse for the care of any patient.

3.

A person who is not a registered nurse may be assigned to care for a patient to the extent consistent with his or her education, experience and authorized scope of practice.

## 4.

The governing body or, if there is no governing body, the medical director, shall ensure the adequacy of treatment, medications and care provided by the nursing staff.
