## 449.154935 Medication

1.

Except as otherwise provided in NAC 449.154933, an administrator or another client shall not administer or assist in the administration of medication to a client.

2.

Medication for self-administration may be kept at the facility. That medication must: (a) Be disposed of immediately when it expires or when a physician orders the medication to be discontinued; (b) Be stored and controlled in a manner that protects the medication from unauthorized use; and (c) Not be used by more than one of the clients.

(a)

Be disposed of immediately when it expires or when a physician orders the medication to be discontinued;

(b)

Be stored and controlled in a manner that protects the medication from unauthorized use; and

(c)

Not be used by more than one of the clients.

3.

The provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection 2 do not apply to over-the-counter medication.
