

## **449.39583 Qualifications of community health worker**

Each community health worker employed or retained pursuant to a contract by a community health worker pool must:

**1.**

Be at least 18 years of age;

**2.**

Demonstrate the ability to provide the services of a community health worker;

**3.**

Understand the provisions of this chapter and chapter 449 of NRS;

**4.**

Demonstrate the ability to read, write, speak and communicate effectively with the clients of the community health worker pool;

**5.**

Provide to the community health worker pool and maintain documentation of either: (a) A certificate of completion evidencing the successful completion of an initial training course for community health workers which is not less than 30 hours and is approved by the Division; or (b) Certification as a community health worker by an accrediting body approved by the Division;

**(a)**

A certificate of completion evidencing the successful completion of an initial training course for community health workers which is not less than 30 hours and is approved

by the Division; or

**(b)**

Certification as a community health worker by an accrediting body approved by the Division;

**6.**

Demonstrate the ability to meet the needs of the clients of the community health worker pool; and

**7.**

Receive annually not less than 20 hours of continuing education related to providing for the needs of the clients of the community health worker pool.
