Medication for self-administration may be kept at the facility. That medication must: (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, be disposed of immediately when it expires or when a physician orders the medication to be discontinued; (b) Be stored and controlled in a manner that protects the medication from unauthorized use; and (c) Not be used by more than one of the residents.

Be stored and controlled in a manner that protects the medication from unauthorized use; and

Not be used by more than one of the residents.

2.

Medication kept at the facility must be controlled and distributed in a manner that is consistent with applicable state and federal law.

3.

The provisions of paragraph (a) of subsection 1 do not apply to over-the-counter medication.
