## **204.15 Windows**

## (a)

Each window opening in the exterior walls that are used for ventilation shall be effectively covered by screening.

## (b)

A room with windows opening onto light or air shafts, or onto an exposure where the distance between the building or an obstruction higher than the windowsill is less than 20 feet, may not be used for resident rooms.
