

205.9 Corridors

(a)

Resident corridors shall have a handrail on both sides with a return to the wall at each rail ending. Handrails shall be detailed and finished for safety and shall be free from snagging. Brackets may not impede the continuous progress of hands along the railing.

(b)

Corridors shall be lighted adequately during the day and night.

(c)

Areas used for corridor traffic may not be considered as areas for dining, storage, diversional or social activities.
