# 209.3 Smoking

#### (a)

Policies regarding smoking shall be adopted. The policies shall include provisions for the protection of the rights of the nonsmoking residents. The smoking policies shall be posted in a conspicuous place and in a legible format so that they may be easily read by residents, visitors and staff.

#### (b)

Proper safeguards shall be taken against the fire hazards involved in smoking.

### (c)

Adequate supervision while smoking shall be provided for those residents who require it.

#### (d)

Smoking by residents in bed is prohibited unless the resident is under direct observation.

#### (e)

Smoking is prohibited in a room, ward or compartment where flammable liquids, combustible gases or oxygen is used or stored, and in other hazardous locations.

The areas shall be posted with "NO SMOKING" signs.

## (f)

Ash trays of noncombustible material and safe design shall be provided in areas where smoking is permitted.

# (g)

Noncombustible containers with self-closing covers shall be provided in areas where smoking is permitted.
