44_73_12_46 Water recreation facilities

Each water recreation facility, including a swimming pool, spa, and water slide operated by a facility and used by any resident or the public, shall be designed, constructed, and maintained using the "Recommended Standards for Swimming Pool Design and Operation," 1996 edition.

The facility shall collect and submit at least one water sample weekly for each swimming pool, spa, or other water recreational facility under the owner's or operator's control to an EPA certified laboratory for bacteriological analysis. The facility shall report any unsafe water sample test results to the department within three days after receipt of such test results. Upon the receipt of a positive water sample the facility shall submit two consecutive negative samples to the department to confirm treatment procedures have eliminated the contamination. If a resample test if positive, the facility shall close the affected water recreational facility and submit two consecutive negative samples prior to allowing guest use of affected water recreational facility. A colorimetric test kit is required for the monitoring and adjusting of disinfectant levels and pH in swimming pool, spa, or other water recreational facilities. A daily log of disinfectant levels and pH shall be maintained for each water recreation facility.
