

R432-150-9 Medical Director

(1)

The administrator must retain by formal agreement a licensed physician to serve as medical director or advisory physician according to resident and facility needs.

(2)

The medical director or advisory physician shall: (a) be responsible for the development of resident care policies and procedures including the delineation of responsibilities of attending physicians; (b) review current resident care policies and procedures with the administrator; (c) serve as a liaison between resident physicians and the administrator; (d) review incident and accident reports at the request of the administrator to identify health hazards to residents and employees and; (e) act as consultant to the director of nursing or the health services supervisor in matters relating to resident care policies.

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
