388-97-0880 Environment

The nursing home must provide and maintain:

A safe, clean, comfortable, and homelike environment, allowing the resident to use his or her personal belongings to the extent possible;

(2)

Housekeeping and maintenance services necessary to maintain a sanitary, orderly, and comfortable interior;

(3)

Comfortable and safe temperature levels:(a) Facilities licensed after October 1, 1990 must maintain a temperature range of seventy-one to eighty-one degrees Fahrenheit; and (b) Regardless of external weather conditions, all nursing homes must develop and implement procedures and processes to maintain a temperature level that is comfortable and safe for residents;
