

388-97-1400 Tuberculosis - Testing method - Required

The nursing home must ensure that all tuberculosis testing is done through either:

Intradermal (Mantoux) administration with test results read: (a) Within forty-eight to seventy-two hours of the test; and (b) By a trained professional; or
