



## Standard Precautions for All Patient Care

#### WHAT TO KNOW

Standard Precautions are used for all patient care. They're based on a risk assessment and make use of common sense practices and personal protective equipment use that protect healthcare providers from infection and prevent the spread of infection from patient to patient.

### Recommendation details

EXPAND ALL +

Perform hand hygiene.

+

- Follow hand hygiene recommendations and training for healthcare providers.
- Follow guidelines for hand hygiene.
- <u>Training course</u> for hand hygiene.
- Clean Hands Count materials.

Use personal protective equipment (PPE) whenever there is an expectation of possible exposure to an infectious material.

- Follow guidelines for isolation precautions.
- Resources to prevent occupationally-acquired infections.

Follow respiratory hygiene/cough etiquette principles.

Ensure appropriate patient placement.

Properly handle, clean and disinfect patient care equipment and instruments/devices. Clean and disinfect the environment appropriately.

- Follow guidelines for disinfection and sterilization.

Handle textiles and laundry carefully.

+

• Follow guidelines for environmental infection control.

Follow safe injection practices.



- Wear a surgical mask when performing lumbar punctures.
- Properly handle needles and review the **Sharps Safety for Healthcare Settings workbook**.
- Follow guidelines for isolation precautions.
- Follow guidelines for infrastructure and routine practices in healthcare personnel.
- Follow guidelines for epidemiology and control of selected infections transmitted among personnel and patients.
- Follow NIOSH healthcare worker information.
