Fiscal Year 2022 (Dates of service 9/1/2021 – 8/31/2022)
 Miscellaneous Fee-for-Service (FFS) Claims Cutoff:

Noon, Friday, August 09, 2024

 Fiscal Year 2024 (Dates of service 9/1/2023 – 8/23/2024) FFS Claims Processing Cutoff:

Noon, Friday, August 23, 2024

**Important:** FFS claims can take up to 24 hours to process after being submitted to Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership (TMHP).

## **Miscellaneous FFS Claims**

September 1, 2024, starts state fiscal year 2025. Miscellaneous claims occur when the service dates are earlier than two prior fiscal years plus the current fiscal year (Dates of service 9/1/2021 – 8/31/2022). Miscellaneous claims for services that are less than eight years old and/or claims that total less than \$50,000 owed to a single legal entity are paid on a first-come, first-served basis using funds appropriated during each legislative session. Miscellaneous claims over \$50,000 and/or for services more than eight years old cannot be paid except as a special line item in the state budget.
