Provider Information Notice (PIN) Summary

PIN 24-07-ASC announces an upcoming informational call about Dementia Care in Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly and Miscellaneous Regulation Changes on Thursday, December 5, 2024.

The Community Care Licensing Division (CCLD) Adult and Senior Care Program is pleased to announce a program-specific live informational call providing information on substantive changes to regulations that address dementia care and other aspects of providing care to residents in Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly (RCFEs). These changes are intended to support person-centered care for residents and their ability to remain in RCFEs, allowing them to age in place in the least restrictive environment that they have come to know as home.

Hosted by the Technical Support Program, this webinar will provide an overview of the updated regulations and include representatives from CCLD's Adult and Senior Care Program and Policy, Training, and Quality Improvement Branch.

The live informational call will take place on Thursday, December 5, 2024, from 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM Pacific Time (US and Canada) via Zoom.
