Subject: Michigan MMPs – Revised Final Contract Year 2020 Member Handbook Chapter

Chapter 4 of the Contract Year (CY) 2020 Member Handbook for Michigan Medicare-Medicaid Plans (MMPs) has been revised to include the preventive HIV screening benefit in alphabetical order in the Benefits Chart in Section D as follows:

HIV screening

The plan pays for one HIV screening exam every 12 months for people who:

- ask for an HIV screening test, or
- are at increased risk for HIV infection.

For women who are pregnant, the plan pays for up to three HIV screening tests during a pregnancy.

Michigan MMPs must communicate the revision to Member Handbook Chapter 4 in accordance with the "Mid-Year Change Notification to Enrollees" instructions in Section 100.4, List of Required Materials, in Michigan's CY 2020 state-specific Marketing Guidance, issued on August 21, 2019.
