Subject: MBI Transition – Timeframes Relaxed for 4Rx and Disenrollments for Failure to Pay Premiums

In preparation for the April 1 transition to the new Medicare Beneficiary Identifier (MBI), CMS is relaxing the required timeframes* for submitting 4Rx transactions and Disenrollments for Failure to Pay Premiums transactions received from April 1 to April 10. Plans must submit any transactions a plan chooses to hold during this period by April 11. Transactions received on or after April 11, are expected to be submitted according to the normal timeframes.

Note that any enrollment information not submitted by April 6 will not be able to be processed by CMS for payment purposes, and will not be reflected in the May payment. These transactions will be reflected in the June payment.

* Required timeframes:

<u>4Rx transactions:</u> Part D sponsors are responsible for submitting a valid plan change transaction type 72 for updating 4Rx data within 72 hours after receiving the transaction reply reports (TRR) for CMS-generated enrollments which include Auto-assigned Enrollments, Facilitated Enrollments, Rollovers, Reassignments, and UI Transactions.

<u>Disenrollment for Failure to Pay Premiums transactions:</u> Plans must submit a TC 51 disenrollment transaction to MARx within 7 calendar days of receipt of the completed disenrollment request.
