The purpose of this memorandum is to announce the migration of the Medicare Part C and Part D IRE Decision Database. Effective May 3, 2022, the decision databases that were previously hosted and maintained by the Part C IRE, MAXIMUS Federal, and the Part D IRE, C2C Innovative Solutions, Inc., will be hosted and maintained on CMS.gov. The new site will continue to provide summaries of all IRE appeals decisions and rationales decided from January 1, 2020.

## Features of the database include:

- Public availability (no required login);
- Redacted protected health information and plan identifiable information;
- Ability to search by various categories (appeal categories, appeal items/services, decision outcomes, etc.);
- Decisions can be exported to CSV; and
- It will be refreshed weekly.
