The purpose of the Interstate Benefit Payment Plan is to establish a method for the payment of unemployment compensation benefits to those unemployed individuals who have earned uncharged wage credits or who have accumulated uncharged credit weeks under the unemployment compensation laws of one or more states and who otherwise might be deprived of benefits because of their

absence from a state (or states) in which their benefit credits had been
