Section 1267-1@ Training Benefits -Definitions

1267-1 Training Benefits -Definitions

For the purposes of Section 1267-2 of these regulations and Section 1267 of the code:

(a)

"Apprentice" means only an individual at least 16 years of age who is in training under apprenticeship standards and a written apprenticeship agreement pursuant to Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 3070) of Division 3 of the Labor Code.

(b)

"Training" means work-related programs approved by the department, including but not limited to, classroom training, instruction, or on-the-job training for an apprentice.
