## 4406 New Hire Training

Panel approval for "new hire training" as defined in Unemployment Insurance Code

Section 10201(g) is subject to the following:

### (a)

Training must be in job-related skills for a specific occupation in a given industry or for specialized occupations across an industry spectrum. In either case, the training must be for occupations with a demonstrable statewide or local shortage of workers.

### (b)

Training may include generic vocational skills such as office automation or customer service as an ancillary component of the overall curriculum for training in skills needed by a specific or specialized occupation.

### (c)

The Contractor must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Panel that it has established a plan for recruiting eligible trainees and prospective participating employers; and, an employer advisory board with prospective participating employers as members.

### (d)

The employer advisory board must give the Contractor guidance on which job-related skills are needed in the specific or specialized occupations, and information about the shortage of workers in said occupations. It must also

provide an ongoing evaluation of the curriculum and other material aspects of the training project.
