5104 Untimely Documents

(a)

Any untimely document filed in a proceeding before the board, including an untimely board appeal, shall specify the reason for the delay.

(b)

If an untimely document fails to specify the reason for the delay, the board may serve notice requiring the party that filed it to specify the reason for the delay by filing and serving the reason within 10 days after service of such a notice. If the party that filed the untimely document fails to comply with such a notice, the board may order an untimely board appeal dismissed, or may deny late filing or service of any other untimely document.

(c)

Within 10 days after service of such a specification of a reason, any other party may file and serve a response to it.

(d)

If the party that filed an untimely document shows good cause for the delay, the untimely document shall be allowed; otherwise an untimely board appeal shall be shall be ordered dismissed, or late filing or service of any other untimely document shall be denied.
