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Section 30304@ Eligibility

## **30304 Eligibility**

### **(a)**

Any unmarried pregnant person under 18 years of age at the time of application who is domiciled in California may receive care and services under this program upon request. (1) A client who reaches her 18th birthday after admission into the program shall remain eligible to receive care and services as long as she is pregnant and attending school.

### **(b)**

An applicant or her parents shall not be required as a condition of eligibility to consent to the applicant's being adjudged a dependent ward of the court under Welfare and Institutions Code Section 300.

### **(c)**

Neither a client nor her parent(s) shall be required to contribute financial support for the care and services provided under this program.

### **(d)**

An applicant shall be eligible for care and services under this program from the date of acceptance of her application up through a maximum of 14 days following termination of pregnancy.
