(A) The information contained in the medical report shall be sufficient to enable the agency to comply with the requirements of Family Code Section 8706 as set forth at Section 35195(a)(1). (5) Dental reports, when they exist. (6) Authorizations for the release of: (A) Medical information. (B) Dental reports, when relevant. (C) Scholastic information, if relevant. (D) Psychological information, if relevant. (E) Medical, psychological and social information about birth parents. (7) Authorization for the child's medical care prior to relinquishment.
