When a relinquishment of a child who is neither detained nor a juvenile court dependent in out-of-home care is revoked by a parent who did not give physical custody of the child to the agency, the agency shall initiate court proceedings to determine custody of the child and whether the plan for adoption can proceed.(1) If the other parent has also relinquished the child, that parent shall be notified immediately of the revocation and the initiation of court proceedings.
