The adoption of a child placed in the applicant's home, under the supervision of a child welfare or adoption agency, has not been finalized and a second child is being placed for adoption in the home. (D) Three years have passed since the existing applicant assessment was completed by an agency and no child, under the supervision of a child welfare or adoption agency, has been placed in the applicant's home during that time.

The agency shall complete an update of an existing assessment by following the format for an abbreviated assessment at Section 35183(b) and shall include information pursuant to Sections 35183(c) through (f), as necessary.
