## (a)

The Department of Health Services shall compile a list of physicians selected for appointment to serve on a three member appeals panel. The physicians shall meet the following standards: (1) Possession of a license to practice medicine in the State of California. (2) Knowledge and experience in the care of HIV-related diseases, transmission and infection. (3) Not be on the staff of, or under contract with a state, county, or city correctional institution or with an employer of a law enforcement employee. (4) Be immediately available upon notification by the Department of Health Services to serve for the specified contract term on any panel in any geographic area specified in his or her contract with the Department of Health Services.

Possession of a license to practice medicine in the State of California.

Knowledge and experience in the care of HIV-related diseases, transmission and infection.

Not be on the staff of, or under contract with a state, county, or city correctional institution or with an employer of a law enforcement employee.
