41517.7 Diseases of the Eye

CCS applicants with at least one of the following eye conditions shall be medically eligible for participation in the CCS program:

(a)

Strabismus, when surgery is required and either until fusion is obtained, or a visibly abnormal deformity is corrected.

(b)

Infections that produce permanent visual impairment or blindness, such as keratitis and choroiditis.

(c)

Infections that require ophthalmological surgery, such as chronic dacryocystitis.

(d)

Other diseases that can lead to permanent visual impairment such as: (1) Cataract. (2) Glaucoma. (3) Retinal detachment. (4) Optic atrophy or hypoplasia. (5) Optic neuritis. (6) Lens dislocation. (7) Retinopathy of prematurity. (8) Persistent hyperplastic primary vitreous. (9) Ptosis.
