50186 Unconditionally Available Income

(a)

An applicant or beneficiary shall, as a condition of Medi-Cal eligibility, take all actions necessary to obtain unconditionally available income. This includes applying for such income and cooperating in supplying the information requested by the agency making the award determination.

Income shall be considered unconditionally available if the applicant or beneficiary has only to claim or accept the income. Such income includes, but is not limited to:

(1) Disability insurance benefits. (2) Benefits available to veterans of military service. (3) OASDI benefits. (4) Unemployment insurance benefits.
