50421.5 Limits and Methods of Property Determination for the Qualified Disabled and Working Individual (QDWI) (a)

To qualify for the QDWI program, the net nonexempt property of a QDWI applicant/beneficiary cannot exceed twice the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) resource limit in accordance with Section 1613, Title XVI of the Social Security Act. **(b)**

Only the property of the QDWI applicant/beneficiary and, if married, his/her spouse, if living in the home, shall be considered in determining net nonexempt property. Such property shall be determined in accordance with Section 50420.
