(a)

The amount actually paid for in-home supportive services provided to any ABD-MN person, or to a SGA-disabled person as defined in Section 50223(a)(2) shall be deducted from the combined nonexempt income of the SGA-disabled or ABD-MN person and the responsible relative, except as limited by (b), (c) and (d).

(b)

The cost of in-home supportive services (IHSS) shall be a deduction only when all of the following conditions are met: (1) The services are provided by a person other than a family member living in the home. (2) The services have been determined to be necessary pursuant to an IHSS needs assessment described in Section 50169(b), and: (3) The costs for these services have been reduced by any veterans benefit designated as an Aid and Attendance payment.
