(a)

Intermediate care facility for the developmentally disabled habilitative means a facility which: (1) Has as its primary purposes, the furnishing of 24-hour personal care, developmental, training and habilitative, and supportive health services in a facility with 15 beds or less to residents with a developmental disability.

Developmental disability is a disability which originates before age 18 and is a permanent substantial handicap as defined in Welfare and Institutions Code

Section 4512. (2) Provides services to the developmentally disabled in the least restrictive community type setting.

Has as its primary purposes, the furnishing of 24-hour personal care, developmental, training and habilitative, and supportive health services in a facility with 15 beds or less to residents with a developmental disability.
