(a)

Close liaison shall be maintained with the participant's personal physician. The personal physician shall retain primary responsibility for the medical care of the participant.

The personal physician shall be: (1) Requested to provide the report of physical examination and medical history required for initial evaluation. (2) Requested to sign the Medi-Cal treatment authorization request for prior authorization if the adult day health center does not have a staff physician. (3) Informed, on a regular basis, of the participant's status and progress.
