55160 Indian Health Service Facility Fee-for-Service Managed Care Plan Reimbursement

If the Indian Health Service Facility provides services as a fee-for-service managed care plan, the department shall reimburse the facility at the applicable reimbursement rate that would have been received by the Indian Health Service Facility if the service had been rendered to a Medi-Cal beneficiary through the Medi-Cal fee-for-service program for each qualifying visit by a member of the fee-for-service managed care plan. In addition, the department shall pay a monthly case management fee established by the department for each member. If the Indian Health Service Facility qualifies for reasonable cost reimbursement, as provided in federal law, the department shall reimburse or recover from the Indian Health Service Facility at least annually an amount equalling the difference between the payments received from the department, excluding case management fees, and reasonable cost reimbursement, or a percentage of reasonable cost, as provided in 1396a.
