66264.110 Applicability

Except as section 66264.1 provides otherwise:

(a)

sections 66264.111 through 66264.115 (which concern closure) apply to the owners and operators of all hazardous waste management facilities; and

(b)

sections 66264.116 through 66264.120 (which concern post-closure care) apply to the owners and operators of: (1) all hazardous waste disposal facilities; (2) waste piles and surface impoundments from which the owner or operator intends to remove the wastes at closure to the extent that these sections are made applicable to such facilities in sections 66264.228 or 66264.258; (3) tank systems that are required under section 66264.197 to meet the requirements for landfills; and (4) containment buildings that are required under section 66264.1102 to meet the requirement for landfills.

(1)

all hazardous waste disposal facilities;

(2)

waste piles and surface impoundments from which the owner or operator intends to remove the wastes at closure to the extent that these sections are made applicable to such facilities in sections 66264.228 or 66264.258;

(3)

tank systems that are required under section 66264.197 to meet the requirements for landfills; and

(4)

containment buildings that are required under section 66264.1102 to meet the requirement for landfills.

(c)

The regulations in this article apply to all owners and operators subject to the requirements of Section 66270.1(c)(7), when the Department issues either a postclosure permit or an enforceable document (as defined in Section 66270.1(c)(7)) at the facility. When the Department issues an enforceable document, references in this article to "in the permit" mean "in the enforceable document."
