66265.273 Waste Analysis

(a)

In addition to the waste analyses required by section 66265.13, before placing a hazardous waste in or on a land treatment facility, the owner or operator shall: (1) determine the concentrations in the waste of any substances which equal or exceed the maximum concentrations contained in section 66261.24, that cause a waste to exhibit the toxicity characteristic; and (2) for any waste listed in article 4 of chapter 11 of this division, determine the concentrations of any substances which caused the waste to be listed as a hazardous waste.

(1)

determine the concentrations in the waste of any substances which equal or exceed the maximum concentrations contained in section 66261.24, that cause a waste to exhibit the toxicity characteristic; and

(2)

for any waste listed in article 4 of chapter 11 of this division, determine the concentrations of any substances which caused the waste to be listed as a hazardous waste.

(B)

Chapter 11 of this division specifies the substances for which a waste is listed as a hazardous waste. As required by section 66265.13, the waste analysis plan shall include analyses needed to comply with sections 66265.281 and 66265.282. As

required by section 66265.73, the owner or operator shall place the results from each waste analysis, or the documented information, in the operating record of the facility.
