66273.60 Applicability

(a)

Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, the owner or operator of a destination facility (as defined in section 66273.9) is subject to all applicable requirements of chapters 14, 15, 16, 18, 20, and 22 of this division, and the notification requirement pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 25153.6.

(b)

The owner or operator of a destination facility that recycles a universal waste that is a RCRA hazardous waste by conducting one or more of the management activities described in section 66273.33, subsections (a)(2)(A), (B), (E) and (F), section 66273.33, subsection (b)(3), and/or section 66273.33.5, subsections (a) through (c), may manage that universal waste pursuant to the reduced requirements specified in this chapter for universal waste handlers.

(c)

The owner or operator of a destination facility that complies with subsection (a) of this section, and that treats and/or recycles a universal waste that is a non-RCRA hazardous waste by conducting one or more of the management activities described in section 66273.72, subsection (b), section 66273.72, subsection (c), section 66273.73, subsection (a)(1)(A) and/or section 66273.73, subsection (b)(1) shall be eligible to store that universal waste prior to treatment of the

universal waste in accordance with the reduced requirements specified in this chapter for universal waste handlers provided such storage and accumulation occur in areas designated for universal waste storage in the facility's permit.

Facilities authorized to conduct these treatment activities on the effective date of these regulations and operating under permits issued prior to the effective date of these regulations shall request a Class 1 modification to their permits to address the universal waste handling activities and designate the universal waste storage locations. This request for a Class 1 modification shall be made pursuant to section 66270.42, subsection (d) for modifications to facility permits that are not listed in Appendix I of chapter 20 of this division.
