66279.91 Recordkeeping Requirements for Total Halogens Testing and Rebutting the Presumption that Used Oil Has Been Mixed with Hazardous Waste

(a)

Used oil recycling facilities and used oil transfer facilities shall maintain records of analyses conducted to meet the requirements of section 66279.10 for at least 3 years.

(b)

Used oil generators, used oil transporters and used oil collection centers shall maintain records of analyses conducted or information used to meet the requirements of section 66279.10 for at least 3 years.

(c)

In addition to the recordkeeping requirements of Health and Safety Code section 25250.1(b) and 25250.19(b), generators claiming that used oil is exempt used oil shall maintain records of analyses conducted or information used to meet the requirements of section 66279.10 for at least 3 years.
